

Tax Credit Scholarship Program

Indiana's Tax Credit Scholarship program was created in 2008 to provide financial assistance for K-12 private school tuition. The program helps thousands of families across the state afford private school through generous donations from individuals and corporations. The program is called "Tax Credit" Scholarship because donors may receive a state tax credit worth 50% of their donation.

To receive a Tax Credit Scholarship, a student must meet the following requirements:

How to Apply for the Tax Credit Scholarship:

- 1. Visit www.myschooloptions.org for more information about your eligibility.
- 2. Find the participating private school of your choice that best meets your child's needs.
- 3. Enroll your child at the school.
- 4. Begin the official tax credit scholarship application process at the school once your student is accepted to the school.
