These non-profits are called Scholarship Granting Organizations (SGO) and currently provide scholarships to thousands of Hoosier students throughout the state.

HOW TO APPLY FOR THE TAX CREDIT SCHOLARSHIP:

- 1.** Determine if your student (between the ages of 4-22) is eligible based on income requirements (see table below). Pre-kindergartners must be 4 by August 1.
- 2.** Choose an eligible school that best meets your child’s needs.
- 3.** Submit the application to your school.
- 4.** Submit income verification documents to the school.
